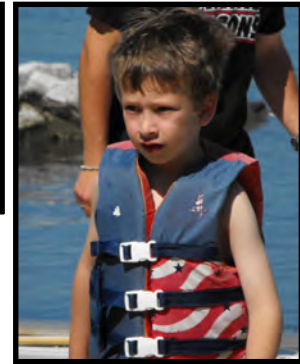
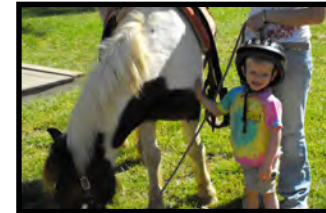
Swim—Swimming, playing and splashing in our 25 meter pool may be the highlight of your day. Compete in the penny dive, swim laps or just float and enjoy.

Sail, Canoe and Sea-Sled—Our premier waterfront, where the Camp Letts peninsula juts into the river, offers a wide range of water activity options. Only one quarter mile from the Chesapeake Bay, the Rhode River sparkles in the sunrise, mists over in the rain, and glows in the sunset. Sailing, canoeing, and sea-sledding are a wonderful way of experiencing Camp Letts.

Waterskiing—Water skiing is one of our most popular activities. In the event of inclement weather or heavy boat traffic, this activity may be cancelled, in this case only you may sign up for the activity again if space is available.

LODGING

YMCA Camp Letts offers a variety of accommodations:

Letts Lodge—Letts Lodge has 8 rooms; each furnished with two bunk beds sleeping up to four guests. Bathroom facilities are shared by families staying in this building.

Lodges—Each of our 12 lodges have a capacity of 24 to 28 guests and are divided into three rooms. The two end rooms are dormitory-style bedrooms with either 10 or 12 beds and a bathroom. The center room is used as a common area for families to share.

Rustic Log Cabins—The Rustic cabins are within walking distance to bath facilities and all program areas and are situated in the woods away from the main camp. We have seven cabins with 12 built-in beds in each. They are perfect for individual families.

Tents—The tenting area is located in Mariner field just a short walk from bathrooms. Tenting is a true camping experience!

DINING

Our talented food service team is always striving to provide the best. Meals are served buffet style with families seated around large, round tables. Family Campers will experience camp as they set and clear their tables. The porch running the length of the hall provides an ideal after dinner location for viewing the sunset and the beauty of the surrounding water and woodland.

CAMPING GEAR

It is necessary to bring sleeping and bath gear; a sleeping bag or twin sheets and a blanket, a pillow, towels, and bath articles. For horseback riding, you will need long pants and closed toed shoes- we provide the helmet. A flashlight, appropriate clothing for weather conditions, and a good book are suggested as well.

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND

Each participant will be given a wristband upon arrival to be worn at all activities and meals. Guests can register for single day passes with the Camp Letts staff upon arrival. You may also register one day guests in advance when booking.

Tents may be set up in the tent area ONLY. Those guests that are tenting have access to the bathrooms next to the Dining Hall.

Pets are NOT allowed on camp property.
